## **Symptom**


The double gearbox is damaged or defective.

## Caused by

The part of the double gearbox which points away from the tractor must be able to move freely. The screw holding this bracket is screwed all the way down, or the gearbox is otherwise unable to move.

## Solution

Replace the mounting bracket with a repair kit which ensures the gearbox mounting can move. Repair kit 131279008.

1. Remove the power transmission shaft which is between the gearboxes on the pump.



2. Release four screws securing the safety funnel and the mounting bracket to the double gearbox pointing away from the tractor. Release the long screw which secures the bracket to the pump mount. Remove the safety funnel and the old bracket. Take care of the safety funnel and two washers for screws that secure the safety funnel.

3. Put new parts in place as shown in the picture.



4. Screw the bracket to the gearbox as shown in the picture.



5. Center the screw with the spacer washers on the picture two and screw in place with a nut on the underside of the pump attachment. This screw can now be properly attached without the gearbox being locked.



6. Put the safety funnel back and fasten it with two new screws that are shorter than four screws before. Use washers which were picked off when the safety funnel was dismantled.
